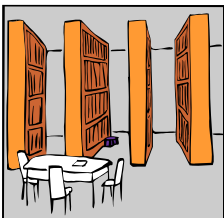

These are some of the things you may do in the library:

- access your e-mail before and after school (not during school).
- access the Internet and library databases
- use the photocopy machine (10 cents a page for black & white, 25 cents a page for color).
- find full-text newspaper and magazine articles on a computer database and print out or e-mail them to your home computer.
- find the same articles at home through the library web page (see passwords below).
- read magazines like Shonen Jump and Dirt Bike while sitting in a comfortable chair.
- receive help in researching your projects or homework.
- ask questions anytime about using the library databases.
- volunteer as a student library aide entitling you to a library pass for any free period.
- use a conference room (with prior approval) to work on a project with classmates.

However, you may not:

- eat while in the library.
- play cards or games.
- check out **current** magazines, though you may check out older issues.

REMEMBER THESE SIMPLE RULES:

During the school day you must:

- ✓ Have your ID to enter the library.
- ✓ Have a WHITE pass from a subject teacher when you are coming from a study hall. Come directly to the library instead of going to your study hall.

Before and after school you may enter without an ID or pass.
